BACKGROUND

Staff received a petition for drainage works by owners, under section 78 of the *Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, requesting replacement of portions of the Eagleson Main Drain, Eagleson Drain "A" and Eagleson Drain "C" Extension. R. Dobbin Engineering was appointed engineer to the project.

DISCUSSION

After passage of the final By-Law the drain queue notification with the signed By-Law will be sent to OMAFRA by staff. Also, the engineer of the projects will be notified to draft tender documents for the construction of the municipal drain.

**MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH MIDDLESEX
BY LAW # 59 OF 2018
EAGLESON DRAIN**

A By-law to provide for drainage works in the Municipality of North Middlesex in the County of Middlesex.

WHEREAS Engineers were appointed to prepare a report under Section 78 of the *Drainage Act R.S.O 1990*, on the improvement of the Eagleson Drain serving Lots 14 and 15, Concession 6 (former East Williams Township) in the Municipality of North Middlesex, County of Middlesex.

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of North Middlesex in the County of Middlesex, has produced a report made by R. Dobbin Engineering Inc. Copies of the report have been previously mailed to all affected owners.

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of constructing the drainage works is **\$104,470.00**

AND WHEREAS \$101,485.00 is to be assessed to the landowners within the Municipality of North Middlesex.

AND WHEREAS \$2,985.00 is the amount to be assessed to roads in North Middlesex.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality pursuant to the *Drainage Act 1990*, according to Section 78, enacts as follows:

1. The report is hereby adopted and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized and shall be completed in accordance therewith.
2. The Municipality of North Middlesex may borrow on the credit of the Corporation the amount of \$104,470.00 being the amount to be contributed by the municipality for construction of the drainage works less the total amount of allowances of \$6,450.00.
3. For paying the amount of \$104,470.00 being:
 - a) The amount assessed upon the lands and roads, except the lands and roads belonging to or controlled by the Municipality; and

- b) The amount required to pay interest on the portion of the amount borrowed, represented by the amount in clause a.
Less the total amount of;
 - c) grants received under section 85 of the *Drainage Act* R.S.O.1990;
 - d) monies paid pursuant to section 30 of the *Drainage Act* R.S.O.1990.
4. This By-law comes into force on the passing thereof and may be cited as, **Eagleson Drain**, By-law number 59 of 2018.
